A Suggested Progression of Sub-skills to Achieve the Reading Standards: Foundational Skills in the Common Core State Standards

Description: This resource helps educators know and understand the sub-skills, or prerequisites, students need to achieve each of the Foundational Skills (K–5) in the Common Core State Reading Standards. Each of the sections in this document targets one grade level. The previous and upcoming grade level is also displayed so a teacher can see what standards and sub-skills should have been learned and what will be taught in the upcoming year. For each reading foundational standard, sub-skills needed to achieve each that standard are listed. Instructional examples are also included which give teachers suggestions of how to teach the sub-skills.
