# A Synopsis of Writing Next: Effective Strategies to Improve Writing of Adolescents in Middle & High Schools

**Description:** This synopsis distills the findings reported in *Writing Next: Effective Strategies to Improve Writing of Adolescents in Middle & High Schools*, a meta-analysis of 133 studies from 1964 to 2005 with special attention to results with students who had learning disabilities. It identifies 11 instructional strategies, listed in decreasing order of effect size.
