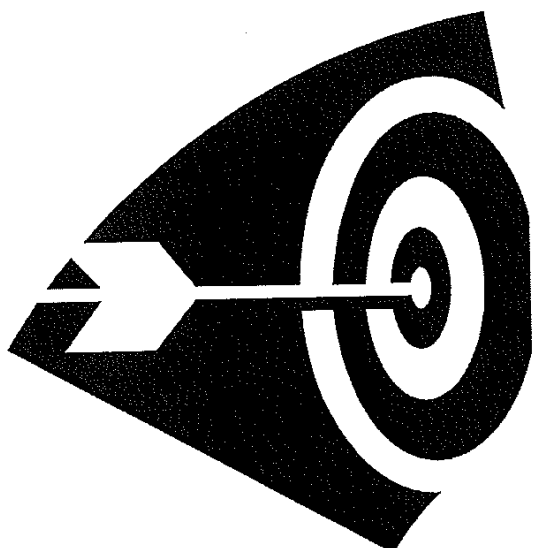

This is an example of the strategy booklets used by Stevenson Elementary School teachers at all grade levels to help their students remember to use comprehension strategies as they read.

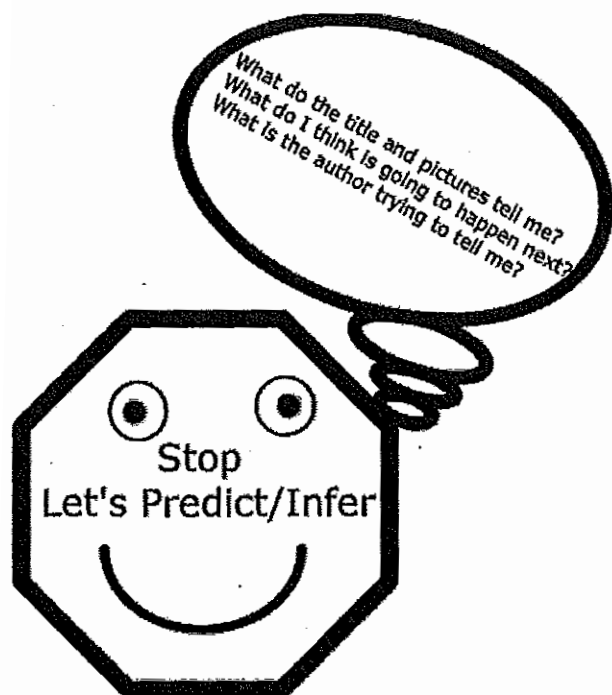
