History of RTI

- Texas has a long history of implementing the 3 Tier Model of Reading Instruction, as well as a large, successful Reading First program.
- TEA has an RTI Coordination Council that meets once a month.

Current RTI Initiatives

- TEA is in the beginning stages of statewide implementation of RTI.
- They are hosting different Professional Development events to build the capacity to implement RTI.
- Main focus currently is on:
 - Creating a guidance document
 - Ensuring that all constituents are receiving consistent messages and assistance from the state through Educational Service Centers and other providers

 - Levels of support by multiple organizations (ESCs, professional organizations, TEA), and
 - Resources: People/Time/Money (inventory all currently available).
 - **Professional Development**
 - Training at federal level for funding options for supporting and sustaining improvement (targeted) initiatives, and
 - Tenets of RTI.
