History of RTI

- RTI has been piloted in Idaho by the Idaho Department of Education since 1999.
- RTI initially was a Special Education initiative, with training provided to schools by the state.

Current RTI Initiatives

- Ongoing training provided to schools, (currently ~200 schools have received training).
- Moving RTI from Special Education to General Education by involving all stakeholders in the RTI Working Group and the RTI Leadership Team.
- Creating a mind map and planning next steps for the upcoming years.
- Planning to hold training focused on RTI implementation in secondary schools late next summer (tentative).
