History of RTI

- Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) initiated a state policy on 3-Tier intervention as a General Education policy in 2005.
- There has been fairly basic introductory training on the 3-Tier process, and school districts have been working to implement this over the last 2-3 years.

Current RTI Initiatives

- Building on the existing General Education policy on 3 Tier Intervention Model.
- Increasing interest in RTI and its relationship to reducing disproportionality from Special Education even though MDE views RTI as a General Education initiative.
- Collaborating with two strong school psychology programs in MS that assist school districts with RTI implementation issues.
- Developing a strategic plan with a state-level.
- Planning additional meetings to coordinate next steps for their State Partners and the State Dept.

 - Ensure more consistent and coherent implementation with increased state support to districts and schools resulting in higher fidelity of implementation,
 - Develop a comprehensive state plan for implementation,
 - Improve top-down and bottom-up communication among all stakeholders, and
 - Identify all available training and technical assistance for each of the three tiers, evaluate it, and develop needed training.
